Associated General Contractors of Alaska, Inc. Scholarship Program

Objective:

The objective of the Associated General Contractors' Scholarship Program is to encourage students to **pursue a career in the construction industry.**

Eligibility:

Applicants for an AGC Scholarship must meet the following requirements:

1. **Applicants career plans shall be to enter the construction industry or a related field (supportive field) such as accounting, insurance, bonding, human resources, etc.**
2. An individual must submit a completed application with the following attachments:
 - a. A one-page essay on "career goals."
 - b. An essay about applicant (does applicant work and go to school, what family obligations, hobbies, etc.)?
 - c. A transcript of:
high school, or
completed college work if in college at the time of application
 - d. Letters of recommendation
3. Applicant must be either a U.S. citizen or permanent resident of the United States and a resident of Alaska.

Selection Criteria:

The recipients of the scholarship awards are selected based on the following criteria:

1. Career Goals
Evaluation is made by assessing the two essays described above (Eligibility 2, a and b).
2. Extracurricular Activities
Describe activities such as:
 - Do you work and go to school?
 - Family obligations?
 - College and community activities?
 - Offices held?
 - Awards received?
 - Participation in sports?
 - Work experience?All described activities are given appropriate consideration.

3. Recommendations:
Each applicant must include letters of recommendation, preferably from teachers or employers knowledgeable with your capabilities and work history.
4. Transcripts:
All graduating high school Seniors, incoming college freshmen, or existing college students; sophomore and/or upperclassmen must include copies of transcripts in application package.

Administration of the Award Program

General

The members of the AGC Education Committee will act as the Scholarship Program Committee and are responsible for selecting the recipients of the awards.

Publicity

Award results will be listed in the AGC newsletter.
